

Eligibility requirements for the WA Seniors Card

1. You meet the age requirements, as listed below:

Date of birth	Age to qualify for a WA Seniors Card
Before 1 July 1957	62 years
1 July 1957 to 30 June 1958	63 years
1 July 1958 to 30 June 1959	64 years
After 30 June 1959	65 years

2. Australian Citizen or Australian Permanent Resident

- You must be an Australian Citizen and/or be a Permanent Resident of Australia.
- Temporary immigration visa holders are not eligible for WA Seniors Card.

3. Reside in Western Australia

You must reside in Western Australia or be present in Western Australia for more than half the year and cannot have permanent residence outside Western Australia.

4. Working Hours

- You must work 25 hours or less per week in paid employment.
- If you are employed on a casual or seasonal basis, the working hours over the last 12-month period is used to determine your average working hours.
- Paid leave (e.g. annual leave, long service leave and sick leave) is included when calculating your working hours per week. For example, if you work part-time on 20 hours per week and receive four weeks of paid annual leave, your working hours is 20 hours per week.
- If you are retiring from full time work, you are considered eligible the day after your retirement if you are no longer working.
- If you are retiring from full time work and reducing to part-time work, then your current part-time hours is used to determine whether you meet eligibility.

List of acceptable identification

You must provide copies of acceptable and valid documents to meet 100 points of identification with your application. These documents must show evidence of your full legal name, date of birth, photo identity, current Western Australian residential address and your ability to reside in Australia as a citizen or permanent resident.

For example, you could provide us a copy of your Australian passport (Category A, 70 points) and Pensioner concession card (Category B, 40 points). The combination of these two documents satisfies evidence of your full name, date of birth, photo identity, Australian citizenship and current permanent address being in Western Australia. A list of accepted documents are below.

Attach legible photocopies with application

If your name is different to your identification, the following documents **must be provided to confirm your change in name**: marriage certificate, divorce papers or change of name certificate from the Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages. These documents do not contribute to 100 points of identification and only verify your name change.
